Estimate of Consolidated Financial Results for FY 2006

For the fiscal year 2006 ending March 31, 2007, MHI is expecting 3,000 billion yen in net sales, 100 billion yen in operating income, 80 billion yen in ordinary income, 80 billion yen in income before tax and 46 billion yen in net income.
