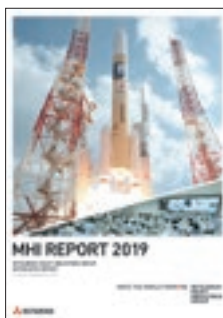
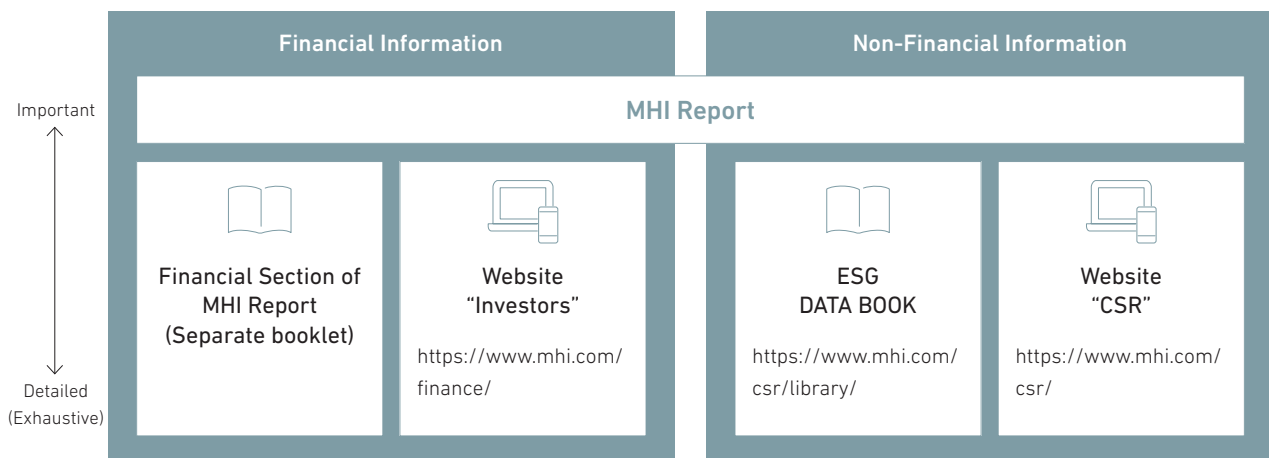
Structure of Information Disclosure
