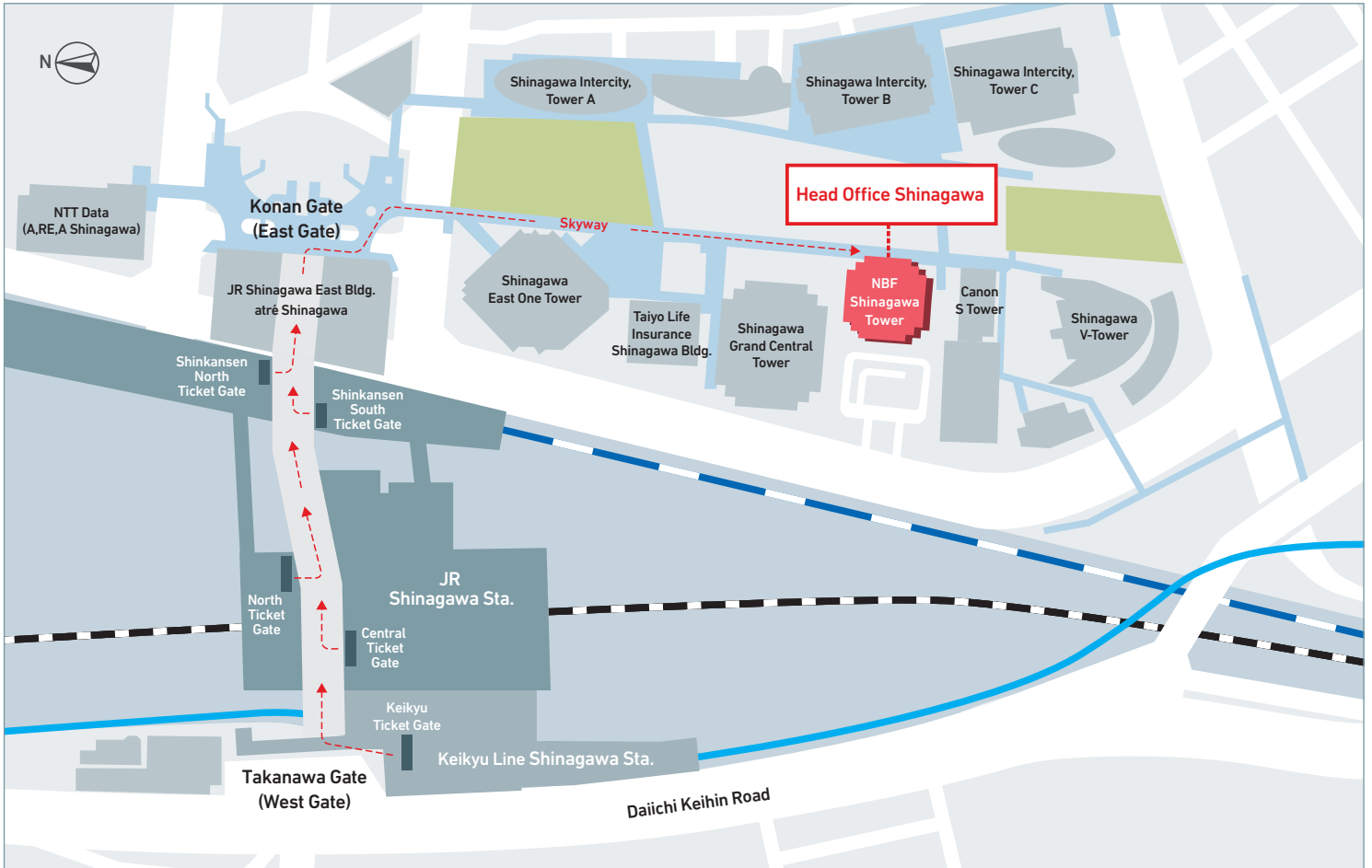


Head Office (Shinagawa) Area Map



- ➔ • An approximate 5-minute walk from Konan Gate at JR Shinagawa Station
- An approximate 10-minute walk from Shinagawa Station on Keikyu Line

- 1 Exit Konan Gate, proceed on the Skyway extending to your right.
- 2 Head Office Shinagawa is the fourth building on the right hand side, after Shinagawa East One Tower, Taiyo Life Insurance Building and Shinagawa Grand Central Tower.
- 3 The name of the office is clearly marked at the entrance of the building. Please enter and proceed to the reception desk.

➔ Access by car

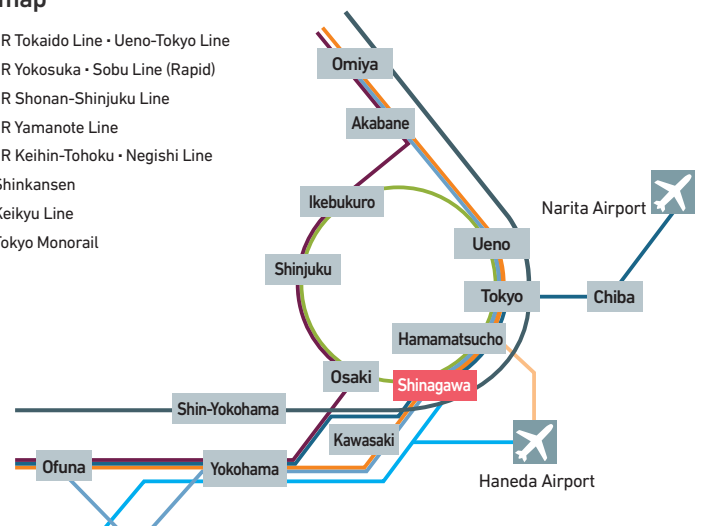
- If you are traveling from the center of Tokyo on the expressway, exit at Shibaura exit.
- Turn right at the fourth traffic light (Konan Elementary School) after taking the Shibaura exit (not counting the traffic light at the exit). (Note: There is a right turn only lane at this traffic light). Turn left at the second traffic light (Shin Konan Minamibashi), then right at the second traffic light (Phillips on your left hand side), proceed straight ahead, take a left turn at the bottom, and you will see a row of buildings to your left. It is the fourth building down the street.

➔ Access from the airport

- From Haneda Airport take the monorail to Hamamatsucho Station, transfer to JR line (either Yamanote Line or Keihin Tohoku Line) and get off at Shinagawa Station. (Approximately 40 minutes from Airport)
- From Haneda Airport take the Keihin Kyuko Line to Shinagawa Station. (Approximately 30 minutes from Airport)
- Approximately 30 to 45 minutes by taxi from Haneda Airport.
- From Narita Airport take the JR Narita Express to Shinagawa Station. (Approximately 70 minutes from Airport)
