# <u>MHI to Split Off Air-Conditioning & Refrigeration Business</u> <u>to Wholly-owned Group Company</u>

Tokyo, February 4, 2016 – Effective October 1, 2016, Mitsubishi Heavy Industries, Ltd. (MHI) will split off its air-conditioning & refrigeration business to a wholly-owned group company of MHI. In separating air-conditioning & refrigeration business, MHI initially will establish a preparatory company, which later will succeed the pertinent business from MHI in an absorption-type company split.

### 1. Purpose of the Company Split

The air-conditioning & refrigeration (AC & R) business is being operated in the market vulnerable to changes in economic trends and environmental regulations. MHI has steadily expanded its AC & R business in such business environment; however, in order to win in the global competition, dynamic business management and agile decision making responding to changes have become indispensable more than ever. Through its initiative to launch a company dedicated to AC & R business by splitting off the business from the company, MHI aims at further strengthening of the competitiveness and expansion of the business in the global market.
